

Be Safe: Campus Expectations


- **Stage** and grass are used for special events

- Do NOT talk to strangers





Be responsible: Dress Code

Pants: Navy blue pants, shorts or skirts


Cold Weather: Sweater, sweatshirt, jacket (no inappropriate images or messages)




